(Latvia), 40 participants from the city of Gradoli (Italy), 30 participants from the city of Il Birgu (Malta), 30 participants from the city of Civitella d'Agliano (Italy)

Location/ Dates: The event took place in Vila Nova de Cerveira (Portugal), from 24/10/2019 to 28/10/2019

Short description:

The day of 24/10/2019 was dedicated to the arrival of the delegates; to the presentation of the official programme of the International Meeting; to the introduction of the participants and their Countries; to a short tour of the city of Vila Nova de Cerveira.

The day of 27/10/2019 was dedicated to sport activities among the delegations; to the intercultural dialogue and exchange of opinions; to a workshop about policies in shelter and inclusion of the Countries involved; to a tour in Viana do Castelo.
